

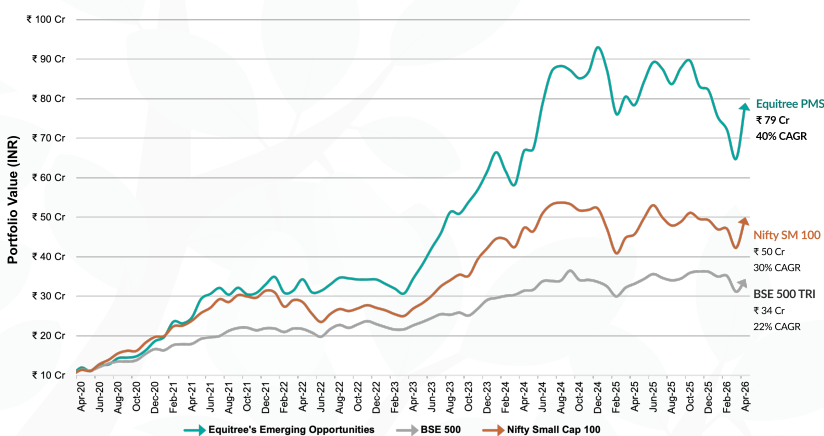

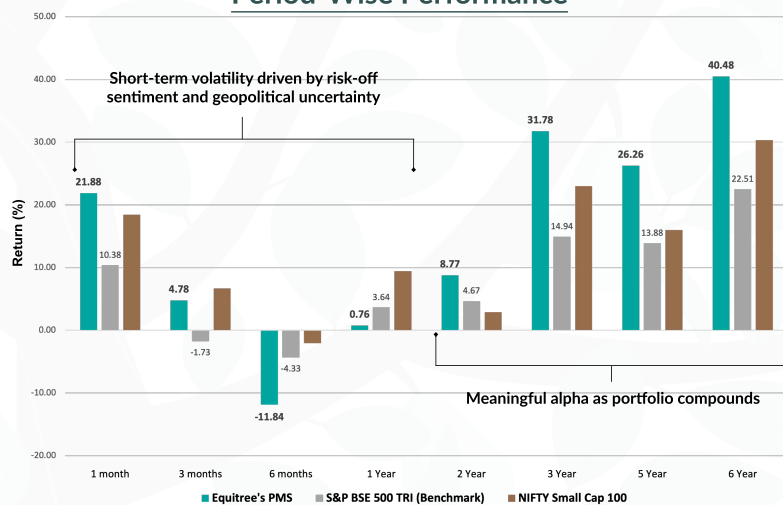

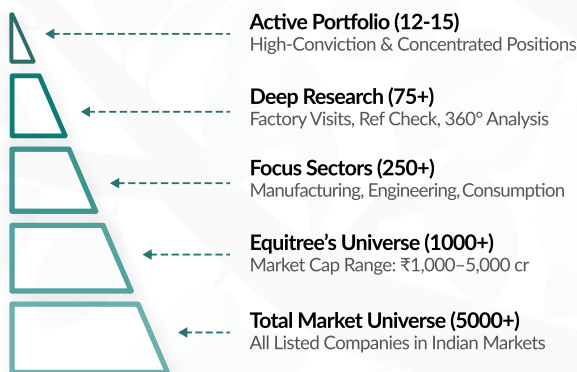
- Emphasis on low PEG ratio (<1) over absolute PE multiples. Exit when PEG>2

- Uncovering mispriced or hidden opportunities below institutional radar.



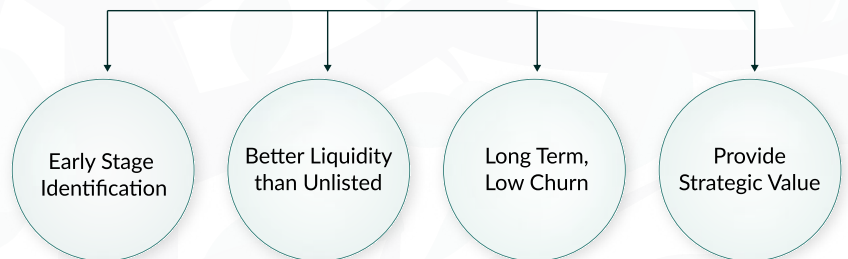

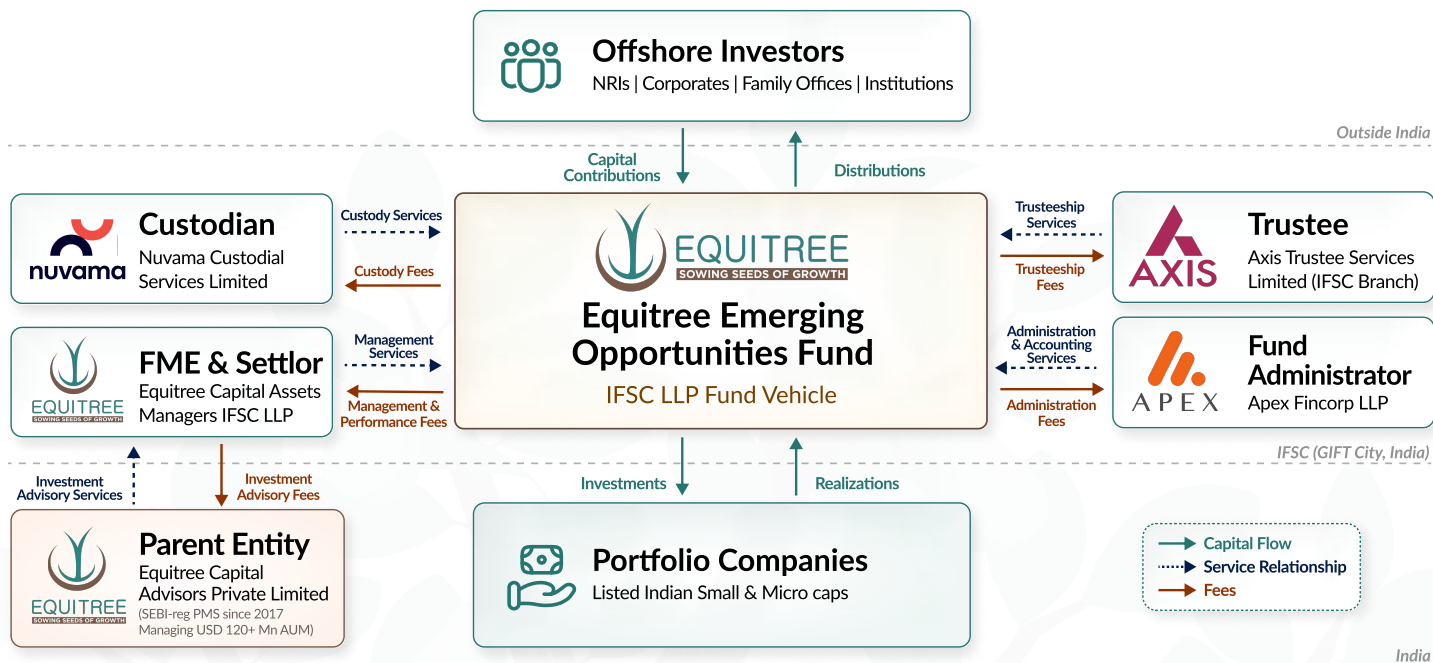

Following crystallisation, a High Water Mark applies, and subsequent carry is payable only once the NAV reaches 2x of the prevailing High Water Mark.
